## BE INVOLVED

- **Membership** — Works with the Chamber on recruiting new members. Ideal for members who are enthusiastic and knowledgeable about Chamber benefits, enjoy meeting new people and making site visits, as well as greeting/talking with members and guests at luncheons/coffees/social events. Membership committee members are automatic ambassadors. Meetings are generally monthly or as needed. Committee Chairs also conduct the Chamber 101 workshops.
- **Ambassadors** — Ambassadors help promote the Chamber by attending ribbon cuttings and various Chamber events. Ambassadors greet visitors and guests at various events and pass new member leads onto membership committee members.
- **Economic Development** — The EDC's primary focus is to facilitate business growth and opportunity in our community. The EDC maintains the economic development website, collects and updates local demographics, participates in regional economic conferences and works with local government officials. Meetings are monthly.
- **Leadership Dripping Springs** — This committee oversees the planning and implementation of an education and development series that broadens knowledge of community issues and sharpens leadership skills. This educational series provides information specific to the Dripping Springs area and promotes emerging and existing leaders in a format that encourages life-long business relationships. Meetings are monthly.
- **Events/Special Task Forces** — Assembled on an as-needed basis to work on a single topic or issue important to the Chamber and businesses.
- **Governmental Affairs** — Monitors the city, county and state governments by attending meetings and reporting pertinent governmental information to our Board of Directors in relation to our Chamber and its mission.
